### PARK REGULATIONS

(Upon signing this permit, the applicant/person responsible agrees to the following conditions)

1. The Town of Pinedale will accept reservations for American Legion Cooley Memorial Park upon payment of reservation fee. Reservations are only accepted during office hours and are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. The reservation information will be posted in the Park where it is visible to the public. However, the Park must be made available for the public to access other areas of the Park.
3. Hours of use are restricted, in that all activity must be completed by 10:00 p.m.
4. No horses or large animals are permitted in the Park. All dogs must be leashed as required by Town ordinance.
5. Any damage to turf areas, trees, sprinklers, structures or general mis-use of the park or failure to clean up the assigned area, is the responsibility of and will be charged to the person in charge and/or reservation deposit retained by the Town of Pinedale to pay for repair/clean-up.
6. No overnight camping is allowed in The American Legion Cooley Memorial Park.
7. Use of motorized vehicles in the Park is prohibited, other than motorized wheelchairs or similar small machines necessary for use of the Park by handicapped persons, and other small machinery necessary for park maintenance.
8. The permittee shall be bound by all Park rules and regulations and all applicable ordinances as fully as though the same were inserted in the permits.
9. The person(s) to whom a permit is issued shall be liable for any loss, damage or injury sustained by any person, by reason of the negligence of the person(s) to whom the permit has been issued.
10. The Town shall have the authority to revoke a permit upon finding a violation of any rule, ordinance or standard. The Sheriff's Department representative shall have the authority to revoke a permit upon finding of a violation of any Town Ordinance.
